I. Welcome & Introductions: All stakeholders were welcomed and introduced themselves.

II. DFC Grant: The approval of the DFC Grant was shared with the distribution of the goals. Funding was shared and how the district would now be the LEA with federal funds being handled through the Business Office. Criteria for the grant was reviewed, including staffing, programs, and evaluation.

Too Good for Drugs, a research-based program for drug/substance abuse education will come through YES (Youth Enrichment Services) and the Town of Islip. The targeted grades will be grade 5 and a middle school grade (6 or 7) for prevention purposes.

The Chris Herren project would be included in the year's actions and include an assembly at Islip High School on February 27th with a parent component the same evening. The event is sponsored by IDEA stakeholders: Islip Schools, North Community Watch Group, Trinity Lutheran, and Rotary.
